To support emerging talents, Accademia Italiana offers **partial scholarships** covering up to 50% of the annual tuition and attendance fees for all **three-year**

Bachelor's degrees and two-year Master's degrees at the Florence and Rome campuses for the **2026/2027** academic year.

ELIGIBILITY

The scholarship contest is open to students willing to challenge themselves and bring their creative vision to life.

WHO CAN APPLY?

Bachelor's Degree Programs

- Students holding a valid secondary school diploma or an equivalent qualification recognized as equivalent to the Italian high school diploma, as well as applicants who already hold a university degree or equivalent higher education qualification.
- Students who will obtain their high school diploma during the 2025/2026 school year or who will graduate during the 2025/2026 academic year are also eligible.

Master's Degree Programs

- Students holding a Bachelor's degree or equivalent qualification obtained in Italy or abroad, consistent with the chosen Master's program.
- Students who will obtain their degree or equivalent qualification before the beginning of the 2025/2026 academic year are also eligible.

WHO IS NOT ELIGIBLE?

- Applicants requesting direct admission to a year other than the first year.
- Applicants who do not meet, or subsequently fail to meet, the admission requirements for the selected Bachelor's or Master's program.

SCHOLARSHIPS

The scholarship covers **up to 50%** of tuition and annual attendance fees for all **Bachelors and Masters programs** at Accademia Italiana campuses in **Florence** and **Rome** for the academic year **2026/2027**.

Scholarship renewal

Scholarships are valid for the entire duration of the study program, provided that the student:

- Successfully completes all exams included in their study plan each academic year;
- Maintains a minimum weighted average grade of 27/30.

SELECTION PROCESS

AND COMMITTEE

Applications will be reviewed and evaluated by a committee composed of **Accademia Italiana faculty members**.

The committee will evaluate projects at its sole discretion based on the following criteria:

- **Quality, originality, and relevance** of the submitted material (presentation video and/or portfolio), with attention to the candidate's ability to express their identity, interests, and creative/design potential;
- **Motivation and interest** in the chosen course, with particular reference to the consistency between the candidate's educational and personal background, professional aspirations, and the objectives of the study path;
- **Growth potential**, understood as the candidate's ability to benefit from the educational experience and actively contribute to the academic community.

HOW TO APPLY

Application deadline:

All required materials must be submitted through the online application form at the following [link](#) or, alternatively, hand-deliver them on the occasion of the Open Day on July 8th at the Rome campus (Viale dello Scalo San Lorenzo 10) or Florence campus (Piazza Pitti 15).

Deadline: July 8th, 2026

Final results:

Candidates will be informed by email by **July 13th, 2026**

Deadline for scholarship acceptance:

Winners must confirm acceptance of the scholarship by sending an email with proof of **payment of the pre-enrollment fee to orientamento@accademiaitaliana.it by July 19th, 2026**. Failure to meet this deadline will result in forfeiture of the scholarship.



Required application materials:

For Three-Year Bachelor's Degrees:

- A presentation video (maximum duration: 2 minutes) and/or a personal piece of work representing the candidate and their interest in the chosen field of study.
- A copy of the high school diploma or equivalent qualification (if available).
- A copy of a valid ID or passport.

For Two-Year Master's Degrees:

- Personal portfolio.
- A copy of the Bachelor's degree or equivalent qualification (if available).
- A copy of a valid ID or passport.

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

By submitting a project, candidates **declare full ownership of their work** and confirm that:

- The contents are not **confidential** and do not infringe **copyright, trademarks, patents, or any third-party rights**.
- The project is **original** and does not involve plagiarism or unauthorized use of others' work.

If the Jury determines that a project is plagiarized or otherwise violates these terms, the candidate will be **disqualified**.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- Accademia Italiana reserves the right **not to award all or part of the scholarships** if, at the sole discretion of the committee, an insufficient number of applications meet the required standards.
- The application form must be **fully completed** and submitted by the indicated deadline.
- **Each scholarship is valid for one academic year** and is automatically renewed if students meet academic performance requirements and are properly enrolled in the following academic year.
- **Only one scholarship application per candidate is allowed.** In case of multiple submissions, only the last one received will be considered.
- The scholarships described in this call **cannot be combined** with other financial aid

provided by **Accademia Italiana** or by other institutions such as universities, companies, foundations, public or private entities, national or international institutions, or the **Azienda Regionale per il Diritto allo Studio Universitario (DSU)**.

- Eligibility for the scholarship is subject to **official admission** to the Bachelor's, Master's or One-Year Master's program.
- If a scholarship recipient does not confirm enrollment within the established deadlines, the scholarship may be reassigned to another eligible candidate. Accademia Italiana reserves the right to **reassign unawarded scholarships to other deserving candidates**.
- The scholarship benefit will be **revoked if the student fails to enroll** within the required deadlines, withdraws from studies, or transfers to another institution, without prejudice to the possibility of enrolling as a full-fee student if places remain available.

PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING

Personal data submitted by candidates with their application will be processed in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (GDPR) exclusively for selection purposes and procedures related to the awarding of scholarships.

Providing such data is mandatory for the evaluation of eligibility requirements; failure to do so will result in exclusion from the selection process.
